NOTIFICATION

In pursuance of the advertisement for the Contractual Posts of Junior Administrative Assistant cum Program Assistant and Junior Administrative Assistant cum Accounts Assistant vide advertisement No. ASSEB/D-I/GEN/98/2026/01 dated 13th March, 2026 and subsequent notification for selection process vide notification No. ASSEB/D-I/GEN/98/2026/07 dated 7th May, 2026, it is hereby informed to all concerned that the **Written Examination of Common Recruitment Test 2026 (CRT 2026)** has been **scheduled on 19th July 2026 (Sunday)**, and the facility for downloading the Admit card will be available in the official website of ASSEB, Div 1 (erstwhile SEBA) **www.sebaonline.org** from **1:00 p.m. of 30th June 2026**.

The Timing of the Written Examination, Venue and other important instructions will be available in the downloaded Admit Card.

The steps to be followed for downloading of Admit Card are mentioned below:

1. Candidate will have to visit the website sebaonline.org and click on the link "CRT 2026 -Download Admit Card". Candidate will be redirected to the recruitment portal.
2. Candidate will have to login with the registered mobile number/ email id and password used while applying for the post. If password is forgotten, Candidate needs to click on the "Forgot Password" option.
3. After successful login, Candidate needs to click on the download Admit Card option and take print out of the downloaded Admit Card.
4. For any technical support please contact or send WhatsApp message in the helpline number provided in the portal.

Important Instructions for the candidates:

- a. The candidates will have to produce hard copy of the Admit Card and a Photo Identity Card Issued by Government such as Aadhaar card, PAN card, Driving License, Voter ID Card to appear in the Written Examination of CRT 2026 and must follow all the instructions mentioned in the Admit Card.
- b. Candidates are advised not to bring Mobile Phones (even in switched off mode) or any electronic equipment or programmable device or storage media devices such as smart watches/digital watches, health bands, electronic pen/ scanner, Bluetooth devices, earphones, microphones or any other such devices either in working or switched off mode capable of being used as a communication device, calculator, pen drives, bits of paper etc. There will not be any arrangement for keeping such materials in safe custody of the examination centre.
- c. Only the hard copy of Admit Card, Proof of Identity, Blue/ Black Ball point pen, pencil, scale, eraser, transparent water bottle without labels, one handkerchief, plastic cards such as debit card/credit card (not more than one), driving license and minimum amount of cash will be allowed to be taken inside the Examination Hall.
